

**CHAPTER 70: GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Transportation. Only when these authorities permit variance or deviation by local government, will additional signs or other control measures be considered by the Department of Public Works. (Ord. 94-12, passed 7-27-94)

**§ 70.03 REQUEST FOR INSTALLATION OF SIGNS; INSTALLATION.**

A member of the public may request that the Director of Public Works install additional signs along county roads in areas where the requester believes additional signs are necessary. The request will contain a written justification of why the requester believes the sign is necessary and a diagram of the area where it is proposed the sign will be placed. If the requested sign is approved by the Board of Commissioners, the requester will be required to install and maintain the sign according to county specifications, or pay the county to install and maintain the sign.

**§ 70.04 ENFORCEMENT BY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT.**

The provisions of this chapter and the use and restrictions on use of county roads required by signs erected by the County Public Works Department will be enforced by the County Sheriff's Department under the provisions of ORS 203.065.

***ROAD SIGNS***

**§ 70.01 EVALUATING NEED FOR SIGNS; PLACEMENT.**

(A) The County Public Works Department will evaluate the need for warning signs or signs imposing restrictions on the use of county roads and make a recommendation to the County Board of Commissioners.

(B) Permanent signs governing the use and restrictions on use of county roads will be placed in the county road right-of-way by order of the County Board of Commissioners.

(C) Upon the request of the family of a victim of an impaired driving crash and when certain requirements are met, a sign can be installed on a County Road at the site of a fatality caused by an impaired driver.

**§ 70.02 CONFORMANCE TO MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES.**

Placement of traffic control signs and other signs restricting the use of county roads will conform to the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, published by the Federal Highway Administration, as amended and supplemented by the Oregon State Department of
