

INVITATION TO BID
Cationic Emulsified Asphalt

Umatilla County is requesting bids for the purchase of CRS-2 for delivery between June 15, 2019 to September 1, 2019. We are also requesting a price on High-Float emulsion in an unspecified quantity for the purpose of doing some test areas. The County will be chip sealing approximately 50 miles of County Road requiring approximately 1300 to 1800 total tons of product, a small amount of that tonnage may be High-Float. Bid will include delivery to various locations in Umatilla County. Sealed bids are due to the Umatilla County Public Works office, 3920 Westgate, Pendleton, Oregon, by 12:00 noon, April 1, 2019, when the bids will be publicly opened and read. The product must meet Oregon Department of Transportation standard specifications for these products and are subject to sampling and testing for compliance.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1.0 SUBMITTAL OF BID

Bids are due to the Umatilla County Public Works office, 3920 Westgate, Pendleton, Oregon, by 12:00 noon, April 1, 2019. The bid should include a cost for the product, plus separately set out the cost for delivery. **Please use bid sheet supplied.**

2.0 DELIVERY

Product must be delivered to Umatilla County

3.0 PAYMENT

Payment for the product will be made immediately after the 10th day of the month following full and satisfactory delivery.

4.0 PERMISSIVE COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT

It is the intent to use invitation to bid as a process for establishing a contract for permissive cooperative procurement. Other Oregon counties or cities within Umatilla County may utilize the original contract awarded under this process to establish contracts or price agreements under the terms, conditions and prices of the original contract for procurement of products with the other county. The contract with the successful proposer will include a requirement that the contractor agrees to extend the terms, conditions and prices of the original contract to other purchasing contracting counties.

5.0 RIGHT TO REJECT PROPOSALS

Umatilla County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any informality in bids or accept the bid deemed most satisfactory to the County.
