

A Guide to Food Safety Practices

Our mission is to protect the health of all foodservice customers. The internet offers an opportunity to share information which may assist you in being a well-informed foodservice consumer.

A person who wishes to serve food to the public is required by law to first obtain a permit from the Umatilla County Public Health Department. These permits are issued following a review of facility plans and menu and assuring, by inspection, compliance with food safety standards and practices. Semi-annual inspections during subsequent operation of the food service assess the operator's success in assuring that routine practices are conducted in a safe and sanitary manner.

If deficiencies are observed during these semi-annual inspections, they are described in an inspection report with reference to a relevant section of the Oregon Food Sanitation Rules. Such deficiencies are typically classified as either Priority - posing a direct or immediate threat to the safety of the food being served; Priority foundation – which facilitates or enables one or more priority items; or Core - representing a failure of cleaning or maintenance.

Ideally, an operation would have no Priority or Priority foundation violations, or none which are not corrected immediately and not repeated. In our experience, it is unrealistic to expect that a complex, full-service food operation can routinely avoid any violations.

Keep in mind that any inspection report is a "snapshot" of the day and time of the inspection. On any given day, a restaurant could have fewer or more violations than noted in the report. An inspection conducted on any given day may not be representative of the overall, long-term cleanliness of an establishment. Also, at the time of the inspection violations are recorded but are often corrected on-the-spot prior to the inspector leaving the establishment.

INSPECTION PROCESS

- **Inspection Frequency:**
Restaurant inspections are scheduled for one (1) inspection every six (6) months.

- **Violations (Three types of violations may be cited):**
 - **Priority Item:** Violations of the Food Regulations, which, if left uncorrected, are more likely than other violations to directly contribute to food contamination, illness, or environmental degradation. Examples of priority items include: poor temperature control of food, improper cooking, cooling, refrigeration or reheating temperatures. Such problems can create environments that cause bacteria to grow and thrive, which puts the consumer at risk for food-borne illness.
 - **Priority Foundation Item:** Violations of the Food Regulations, which, if left uncorrected may support, facilitate, or enable Priority Items. Examples of Priority Foundation Items include: proper hand washing locations, proper date marking procedures, and proper cleaning of food contact surfaces.
 - **Core Item:** Violations not directly related to the cause of food-borne illness, but if uncorrected, could impede the operation of the restaurant. The likelihood of food-borne illness in these cases is very low. Core item violations, if left uncorrected, could lead to Priority or Priority Foundation Items. Examples of Core Item violations include a lack of facility cleanliness and maintenance or improper surfaces or equipment being used in the facility.

- **Types of Inspections**
 - **Semi-annual:** This is a scheduled inspection, unannounced to the restaurant. An inspector will conduct a complete inspection covering all items in the regulations for compliance. **ONLY SEMI-ANNUAL INSPECTIONS ARE SCORED**
 - **Re-inspection:** This is an inspection for the specific purpose of re-inspecting items that were not in compliance at the time of the semi-annual inspection.
 - **Consultation:** The inspector visits the restaurant to present a formal training event for the restaurant's staff.
 - **Complaint:** This is an inspection conducted as a result of a complaint received by the health department. The specifics of the complaint will be evaluated and discussed with the person in charge.

FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM

Only restaurants are scored according to the Oregon Food Sanitation Rules.

Oregon adopted the 2009 FDA Food Code on September 4th, 2012 with new violation information. The new scores are a direct connection to foodborne illness and food safety practices.
