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Intermittent and Seasonal Information

License Fee

(5 days or more before event)

Single Event, Seasonal, or Intermittent Permit = \$77

Not for Profit – Single Event = \$34

Not for Profit - Seasonal or Intermittent Permit = \$50



Late Fee

(Less than 5 days before event)

Single Event, Seasonal, or Intermittent Permit = \$77

Not for Profit - Seasonal or Intermittent Permit = \$55

Intermittent Temporary Restaurant License	Seasonal Temporary Restaurant License
Multiple events at the same location Permit expires no later than 30 days after issuance	One event with multiple occurrences at the same location Permit expires no later than 90 days after issuance
An operational review is required for first time applicants	

All licenses are owner, location, and event specific. For example, if a vendor is licensed for Pendleton Farmer’s Market, the vendor is **not allowed** to use the same license for any other event or farmer’s market.

If the event lasts longer than 90 days, such as a farmer’s market, than you may need to obtain more than one permit. For example, an event that starts on the first Saturday of May, and operates every Saturday at the same location until the end of August (112 days). *This scenario would require a one-time operational review, and two Seasonal Temporary Restaurant Licenses. One for the first 90 days, and a second for the remaining 22 days.*

Please remember:

All food and single-service articles must be purchased the day of the event.

OR

Stored in a licensed facility if they are held from one week to the next.

Any facility used for preparation or storage must be licensed as a restaurant!!!
