POSITION: Public Health Nurse II-IV Early Childhood/CaCoon

DESCRIPTION: Provide public health nursing services in health promotion, prevention and disease control to families and children in a variety of different settings. Work with the community partners to promote health in the early childhood population. Serve as a system navigator/service coordinator for families and children. Provide home visit services to newborns, children, and youth enrolled in the Oregon CaCoon care coordination program for children with disabilities and special health care needs.

REQUIREMENTS: Graduation with a BSN from an accredited school of professional nursing and at least one (1) year of public health experience; or an ADN and four (4) years of public health home visit experience working with families with children ages 0 to 3 years, with a knowledge of infant and child development and parent/child attachment. Experience working with children and youth with complex health conditions or disabilities preferred.

PHN II: Graduation with a BSN from an accredited school of professional nursing, or ADN and four (4) years public health home visit experience or combination of education and experience.

PHN III: Graduation with a BSN from an accredited school of professional nursing and four (4) years of public health experience or combination of education and experience, or BSN with Masters Degree in a related field; or ADN and eight years (8) years public health home visit experience or combination of education and experience.

PHN IV: Graduation with a BSN from an accredited school of professional nursing and four (6) years of public health experience or combination of education and experience, or BSN with Masters Degree and two (2) years of experience in a related field, or ADN and fifteen (15) years public health home visit experience or combination of education and experience.

In addition, the applicant must:

- Hold a current Oregon Registered Nurse license
- Valid Oregon driver's license with a satisfactory driving record. Work site location assignments will be based on community need and is subject to change. Your work week may require you to report to different Umatilla County Public Health locations during the week. Travel to and from your home to work site is not

work time and is at your expense.

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- Bilingual desired.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision, ability to work with clients of varying ages, gender, race, ethnicity, religious and social backgrounds.

Physical Requirements-

The physical demands are typical of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Requires sufficient ambulatory ability to drive throughout the county and state, to deliver care, and to provide face-to-face services in a variety of settings in the community, including but not limited to schools, hospitals, clinics, and client homes. Computer literacy with strong typing and computer skills required. Must be willing to work a flexible schedule when necessary, to meet client needs. Must have the ability to work in an office that is environmentally controlled; possess sufficient hand coordination to perform keyboarding and data entry; arm/hand movements to retrieve work materials and operate a variety of general office equipment. The position is frequently required to sit, walk, stoop, bend, kneel, reach, stand, grasp, talk, hear, see, and lift up to 25 pounds.
