### 2022-2023 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for April 5, 2023

Seven Supplemental Budgets are scheduled for consideration on April 5, 2023. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

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Budget Order 2023-84 Victim Witness Assessment

The <u>Victims Conference Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$48,500, an increase in Materials & Services of \$23,475 and an increase in Contingency of \$25,025.

Budget Order 2023-86 2050 Plan Fund

The <u>Central Water Project Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$500,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$500,000.

Budget Order 2023-87 Facilities Improvement

The <u>Facilities Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$300,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$1,700,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$1,400,000.

Budget Order 2023-88 PERS Reserve

The <u>Stimulus Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$1,010,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$1,010,000.

Budget Order 2023-91 Fleet Management

The <u>Fleet Management Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$154,000, an increase in Local Revenue of \$212,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$616,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$250,000.

# Budget Order 2023-94 GF-Cultural Specific Grant

The <u>Cultural Specific Grant Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$143,652, an increase in Personnel Services of \$30,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$3,000, and an increase in Contingency of \$110,652.

# Budget Order 2023-97 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The <u>Economic Development Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers In of \$1,500,000, and an increase in Materials & Services of \$1,500,000.
