Since we only had a quorum by Diane participating via phone, we had a quick meeting with little preamble. Robert Pahl sent a copy of the spreadsheet, stating that we currently have a balance of \$44,006.97; then an updated one indicating that we have \$54,796.97 available for grants. After discussion, we decided to move forward with caution, not knowing for certain if either amount includes the already dedicated funding of \$21,604.00 for Phase II of

the Walking Trail.

(For the sake of record keeping it is noted here that, according to the minutes of the Dec. 31, 2021 meeting, we reportedly had a balance of \$54,796.97 <u>prior</u> to awarding funding to the Echo Fire Department. Awarding them the total of \$10,790.00 left the Echo Benefit Board with a presumed balance of \$44,006.97.)

Only one entity applied for funding this go-around:

• Echo Rural Fire Protection District requested \$5,199.00, full funding, for 5 nozzles for their new fire engine.

WHEREAS on January 1, 2010, the Echo Community Benefit Plan was formed by the Board of Commissioners;

WHEREAS the purpose of the Echo Community Benefit Plan is to serve as a conduit entity to allocate and distribute certain funds made available for local community projects, services or other benefits within the geographic area defined by the boundaries of the Echo School District, and initially is funded from payments received for the Echo Windfarms Project pursuant to the Community Services Fee provisions of the Oregon Strategic Investment Program that began in 2009, and which will continue to 2024;

WHEREAS the Echo Community Benefit Plan Board reviews grant requests for the funds and makes a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for review and approval;

WHEREAS the Echo Community Benefit Plan Board has made recommendation of \$5,199 for a recipient of a 2022 grant for the funds received from the Echo Windfarms Project with an approximate balance of \$44,000;

WHEREAS this is the first round for 2022 grants.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners orders that the following distribution of Echo Community Benefit Plan funds is approved:
