Budget Order 2026-14 Facilities Improvement

The <u>Facilities Improvement Program</u> requires a Budget Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Transfers Out of \$1,300,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$1,300,000.

Budget Order 2026-15 General Fund - CIS

The <u>General Fund CIS Program</u> requires a Budget Transfer to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$12,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$12,000.

Budget Order 2026-16 General Fund - Jail
