There are a total of 7 computers to be replaced. The following are the total costs:

(Computers being replaced: RD-OFFICE04, RD-OFFICE05, RD-SHOP01, RD-SHOP02, RD-SIGN02, RD-SURVEY1801, LAP-RD-WEED01)

7 computers = \$7,350 (\$1,050 each)

7 Microsoft Office licenses = \$2,331.84 (\$333.12 each)

3 Adobe Acrobat Standard licenses = \$850.74 (\$283.58 each)
