

**NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED FORMATION
OF MEACHAM EAST LIVESTOCK DISTRICT
UMATILLA COUNTY**

In accordance with ORS 607.018, on January 19, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 130 of the Umatilla County Courthouse, 216 S.E. Fourth Street, Pendleton, Oregon, the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners will conduct a continued public hearing on a petition for the formation of the proposed Meacham East Livestock District. Generally, the area of the proposed district includes property lying East of Interstate 84 in Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, Township 1 North, Range 35, and in Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 35, East of Willamette Meridian, Umatilla County, Oregon, located in the vicinity of Meacham, Oregon. A map of the proposed district is attached to this notice. Owners of property within the proposed district were mailed a notice of this hearing.

Classes of livestock that would not be permitted to run at large within the livestock district would be animals of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine.

Due to distancing requirements and restrictions, personal attendance at the hearing is discouraged, and appearance by telephone or through written comments is preferred. The proceedings will be conducted by telephone through 541-728-0275 and all interested persons may call in to that number to appear at the hearing and present evidence relating to the petition for formation. A limited number may also be able to participate through Google Meets. If you want to appear in person, or through Google Meets, spacing will be limited and you will need to reserve space by contacting 541-278-6208.
