3.0 <u>DELIVERY</u>

Bidders shall set forth the date of delivery in the space provided on the Bid sheet. Delivery date shall be taken into consideration before awarding the contract.

The equipment herein specified shall be delivered to the Umatilla County Guardian Care Center, 431 SE 3rd Avenue, Pendleton, Oregon.. Any necessary parts for operating the equipment that are not mentioned in the specifications are, by this inference, included and shall not become a cause for extra compensation to the successful proposer.

4.0 PAYMENT
