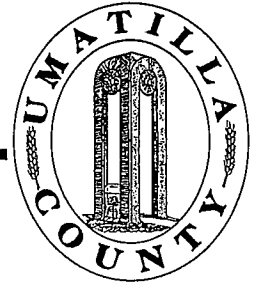

Subject: Umatilla County Hazard Mitigation Plan (Stakeholder Survey)

The National Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all jurisdictions eligible for FEMA mitigation project grants to develop and implement a natural hazard mitigation plan to remain eligible for the Post Hazard Mitigation Grant program as well as Cost/Benefit ratio pre-disaster mitigation project grants. Adoption of a plan is not mandatory, and does not obligate a jurisdiction to undertake particular actions. Rather, it demonstrates a jurisdiction's commitment to overall public safety.

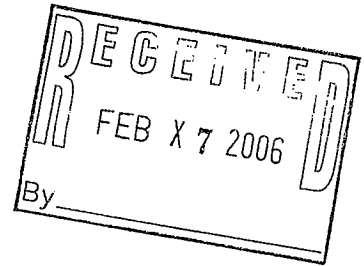
