COPY OF ORDINANCE NO. 837.

To vacate the following alleys and parts of streets in Cole's Addition, (formerly M'Allister's Addition) to The City of Pendleton, to-wit, all of the alleys running north and south through Blocks Numbered 3, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of said Cole's Addition, and all that part of Wilson Street lying between the west line of Ray Street and the east line of Arc Street, and all that of Washington Street lying between the east line of Ray Street and the West line of Cole's Addition (the same being the southerly projected line of said Block 9) and all that part of Arc Street lying between the north line of Jackson Street and the south line of Wilson Street.

Whereas, the Irvington Heights Land Company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Oregon, having its principal office at Pendleton in that State, filed, on January 21, 1915, with the Recorder of The City of Pendleton, its petition praying that the Common Council of said City to absolutely vacate the alleys and parts of streets hereinafter particularly described in Cole's Addition, (formerly M'Allister's Addition) to The City of Pendleton aforesaid, as per recorded plat thereof in the office of the recorder of Conveyances of said Umatilla County, Oregon, which petition was in all respects regular and in due form; and

Whereas, notice of the pendency of said petition was given for more than 30 days by publication of said notice in the daily edition of the East Oregonian newspaper, which is printed and published in The City of Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, the last publication of said notice having been made in said newspaper on January 22, 1915, and the last publication thereof having been made on the 25th day of February, 1915, due proof whereof having been filed with said City Recorder; and

Whereas, the written consent of the Irvington Heights Land Company, a corporation, which is the person owning the property immediately adjoining that part of the said streets and alleys asked to be vacated in said petition, and hereinafter described, has been obtained, and was duly filed with said City Recorder on March 23, 1915, which written consent has been duly acknowledged by the President and Secretary of said corporation prior to its being so filed; and

Whereas, all of said alleys and parts of streets asked to be vacated in said petition are within the corporate limits of The City of Pendleton aforesaid, and no opposition or objection to the said petition, or to the vacation of any part of said alleys or parts of streets has been made or presented by any person up to this time, and more than 30 days having elapsed since the said petition was filed with said recorder; and

Whereas, it now appears to the Common Council of The City of Pendleton that the prayer of said petition should be allowed; therefore:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF PENDLETON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all of the following alleys and the following parts of the streets hereinafter named, to-wit, all of the alleys and alleyways running north and south through Blocks Numbered 3, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Cole's Addition (formerly M'Allister's Addition) to The City of Pendleton, as per recorded plat thereof in the office of the Recorder of Conveyances of Umatilla County, Oregon, and also all of that part of Wilson Street lying between the west line of Ray Street and the east line of Arc Street, and all that part of Washington Street lying between the east line of Ray Street and the west line of Cole's Addition (the same being the southerly projection line of said Block 9) and all that part of Arc Street lying between the north line of Jackson Street and the south line of Wilson Street, shall be and the same is hereby declared and ordained to be, absolutely vacated, and shall not be considered or recognized as an alley, or part of street or thoroughfare in any manner from and after the time this ordinance takes effect.
