I, Virgil Waggoner, after first being duly sworn say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the lands as represented by the foregoing and annexed plat, to be known as Miller's Addition to Milton; that I planted a proper monument as by law provided indicating the initial point of such survey, said monument being a galvanized pipe 2 inches in diameter and 44 inches long, set 6 in. below the surface of the ground, and I set for a reference monument, 10 ft. easterly on the South Boundary of Fair St. a 1/2 in. diameter Iron pipe 6 in. above ground, and I set for another reference monument 11 1/2 ft. westerly on the southerly boundary of Fair St. a 3/4 in. diam. Iron pipe, 6 in. above ground. Said Initial Point is 580 1/2 Ft. South of the N.W. Cor. of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 Sec 12 T 35 N R 55 E W.M.

The land embraced in the aforesaid Miller's Addition is described as follows: Beginning at a point which is 580 1/2 ft. South of the N.W. Cor. of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec 12 T 35 N R 55 E W.M., thence S 65° 04' E a distance of 371 1/2 ft.; thence S 49° 35' E a distance of 67 1/2 ft.; thence East a distance of 285 1/2 ft.; thence N 25° 04' W a distance of 547 1/2 ft.; thence S 65° W a distance of 189 1/2 ft. more or less to the point of beginning.
