



**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey was to partition out a parcel of land from that parcel belonging to Joseph G. Ramos for John Ramos.

Bearings are based on a survey by Krumbeln Engineering Co. for the Echo School District dated March 7, 1979, Umatilla County Surveyor Number G-1130-C in which the Northwest corner of Sec. 22, T3N, R29E, W.M., and a witness cap to the West were set.

Control for the East side of this property was the centerline of the Union Pacific Railroad mainline as tied in the field. Control for the Southerly and Westerly lines were canals which were also field tied. The North line of the property was designated by the client.
