



**NARRATIVE**

PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO SET THE CORNERS OF LOTS 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 OF BLOCK 62 OF THE PLAT OF THE ORIGINAL TOWN OF FREEWATER.  
 THE STREETS ON ALL SIDES HAD BEEN SURVEYED IN C.S. # 10-132B IN 2010. THE MONUMENTS FOUND CHECKED OUT AS ESTABLISHED AND THOSE DIMENSIONS WERE USED TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS. THE NORTH LINE IS A CONCRETE BLOCK WALL AND WASHERS WERE SET ON TOP OF THE WALL TO SHOW LOCATION. BEARINGS ARE BASED UPON C.S. #10-132-B
