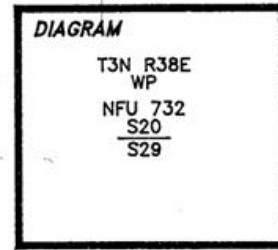

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" by 28" aluminum pipe, with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, 16" in the ground with a white SurvKap Mag. reference set in the bottom of the hole, marked as shown, from which:

6" Douglas Fir bears N. 5 1/2" E., 28.3 feet, scribed "WPS20" "BT" on double blaze with 3/4" brass washer stamped "RLS 2308" nailed to the lower blaze.

9" Douglas Fir bears S. 50" W., 53.3 feet, scribed "WPS29" "BT" on double blaze with 3/4" brass washer stamped "RLS 2308" nailed to the lower blaze.
