MONUMENT: DESCRIBE NEW MONUMENT SET, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE EXISTING MONUMENT

Set at a point where the center thread of Johnson Creek intersects the center thread of an unnamed creek, a 6 foot steel fence post with Land Survey Monument and Wilderness Boundary signs.

ACCESSORIES: DESCRIBE NEW BT'S WITNESS OBJECTS ETC. ESTABLISHED, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE EXISTING EVIDENCE 21" White Fir, N. 52° E., 68.7 feet, scribed "WB/689" "BT".

RM, 5/8" by 24" rebar with 3 1/4" aluminum cap, set flush with ground, S. 74 1/2° E., 36.6 feet, stamped "RM WB 689 36.6 FT 2308 1996" with an arrow pointing toward the corner.

The BT is double blazed and has a 3/4" brass washer stamped "RLS 2308" nailed to the lower blaze by the "BT" scribing.
