Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc.: This corner was originally set by U.S. Deputy Surveyors William Odell and William Lewis under their contract No. 110 dated February 7, 1865. The Surveyor General's notes state "set post corner, drove charred stake, dug pits and raised mounds per instructions". Krumbein, in 1982, shows a 2" pipe of unknown origin at the corner (Survey 82-46-B).

Monument(s) & Accessories Found (Condition & Source):

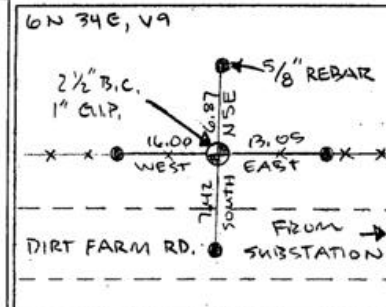
At the southwest corner of section 28, T6N R34E, found a 2"x54" iron pipe at the surface in east-west fence line.

Monument Set (Procedures & Description):

Set 1" x 30" flared end Galvanized Iron pipe with 2 1/2" brass cap stamped (see example below).

New Accessories: WE SET:

A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears East ~ 13.05 feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign to Southwest face of the Locust Fence Post. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears South ~ 7.42 feet from the corner. No steel t-post set or a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears West ~ 16.00 feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign to Southeast face of the Locust Fence Post. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears N 5°E ~ 6.87 feet from the corner. No steel t-post set or a Umatilla County Bearing Object Sign.

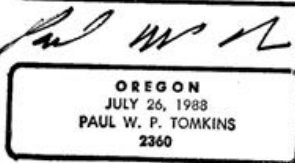
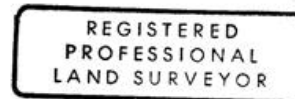
