We find said route practicable and would most recommend the same respectfully to be declared a public highway of Umatilla County Oregon the cost of construction will be about \$90.00 consisty of 3 18" corrugated pipe. The petitioners to place the pipe in the ditches and perform necessary labor. The dammages to be sustained by the property owners by reason of location of said road will be nothing.
