RESOLUTION.

County Road No. 111, 360 and 583

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described road, highway or part thereof, is useless as a part of the general road system, and/or dangerous, and/or burdensome to maintain, and that the public will be benefitted by its vacation, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that said road, highway or part thereof, be vacated by resolution of this court, and

WHEREAS, the termini of the said road or highway, or part thereof, proposed to be vacated is as follows, to-wit:

All that part of Road No. 111, 360 and 583, all being the same road;
beginning at the South line of the Cobb Road, running thence South
to a point 60 feet North of the North line of the Russell Blacker
property, said point of ending being the point of beginning of a new
road 60 feet in width, running East to an intersection with the
Oregon-Washington Highway.

All being located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 6
North, Range 35, E.W.M.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the above entitled court sitting for transaction of County business, at the regular term of said court for the month of January A. D. 51, in the County Court Room in the County Court House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, Oregon, that proceedings to vacate said road or highway or part thereof be undertaken, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public necessity for the vacation of said road or highway is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: It is burdensome to maintain and is no longer required
as a part of the general road system of the County. The public will be
better served by the new approach mentioned in the above description.

and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forthwith served upon the County Engineer
County Engineer upon receipt of which notice the said County Engineer be and he is hereby ORDERED to examine the above described road, highway or part thereof, and report to this court in writing on the same his opinion as to whether the said road, highway or part thereof should be vacated, whether the same is in use or has been in use, whether it will be advisable to preserve the same for a general road system in the future, whether the public will be benefitted by the vacation, and all other facts, matters and things which will be of importance to the said Court, and cause the said report upon its completion to be filed with the County Clerk of said County and State.
