

And it appearing to the Court from the proofs and papers filed herein that the law has been complied with in the matter of posting of notices, as by law required, and a good and sufficient bond given, duly approved by the Court, and there being no remonstrance on file against said petition.

It is ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court issue a license to R. Haycock & Son to sell spirituous liquors in less quantities than one gallon at their place of business in Echo Precinct, Lemaitre County Oregon, for the period of one year, commencing July 9th 1892 and ending July 8th 1893.

Now on this day comes the report of the Viewers heretofore appointed at the May Term 1892 of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of this Court, to wit the July Term 1892, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrances on file against the location of the said proposed road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with said report of said viewers, and that the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
