

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts, where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 36 in township 6 North, of Range 35 E.W.M. Running thence West one-fourth mile to the Southwest corner of the said Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of section 36 Township 6 North, of Range 35 E.W.M. and connecting with the County road at each terminal.

That said road is of Public Necessity in that, the Rural rail is carried over it and that the patrons of school District #108 are obliged to travel an extra three-fourth mile on account of this not being open and in condition to travel.

Said road to be thirty feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
