Report of Viewers, Field notes and Plat of Survey of
Road No 383, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Commencing at the mouth of Gordon Gulch, about
200 yards south east of the north west corner of Sec 5
Township 4 N. Range 36 E W M. thence running easterly
up Gouse Creek about 2 1/2 miles to James Kitch's place
thence crossing said Gouse Creek and following up the
Berry Gulch in a southeasterly direction about 2 miles
to the head of the gulch, thence southerly along the line
between Berry Reed and John Kerst about 80 rods
intersecting the Basket Mountain road at the South
west corner of the north half of the north east quarter
of Sec 14 Town 4 N. Range 36 E W M.
Said Road to be forty feet wide.

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County,

We, the undersigned, the viewers heretofore appointed to
view and locate Road No. 383, submit the following report;

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Field Notes of Road Survey No 383 for Umatilla County, Oregon.

I meet Geo. Dehaven, Henry Frasier and A. M. Elam, viewers on County Road No 383 and duly administered oath to each. We call E. R. Thomson and J. C. Hill to chain and mark, each of whom was duly sworn.

I set initial post below traveled road on N. side of loose creek, at mouth of Gordon Gulch, 5 + 8 lks S.E. of NW cor. of sec. 5 in 2 + NR. 36 E, in mid. of stone 2 ft. h x 4 ft. base, and from initial post I run, on Magnetic course, along traveled road.

All the posts are of proper size and marked and set in mounds according to law; the road follows the old traveled road from the beginning to Mouth of Berry Gulch, thence up said gulch, intersecting line N+S through Sec 14 at 4 miles 53 1/4 chains; thence south on this center Sec line to its terminus.

The original surveys in this vicinity have been quite carelessly made, and while the courses and distances given in these notes may not intersect subdivisional lines at true points, the road is well marked by angle and mile posts and by its being the only place for a road in the vicinity thereof.

God saved the viewers all work, except locating angles & miles, by laying out Road 383 himself.

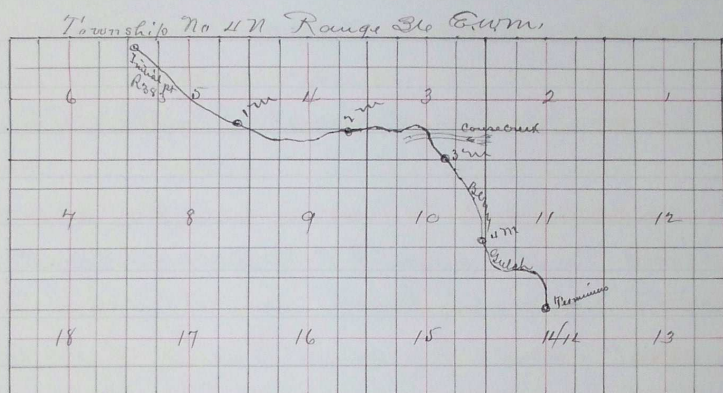

The original surveys in this part of the Township have been poorly made and this may throw the platting out of proper connection with some of the lines of original surveying. The said road 383 however is well marked with angle and mile stakes and from its beginning at the mouth of Gordon Gulch on N side of Course Creek, the road is located upon the old traveled road north of Course Creek until it reaches Berry Gulch coming in from the SE, thence the road crosses Course Creek and up Berry Gulch whence it can not be mistaken even were there no other marks, for the great cause of all things has so build up the ground in the vicinity of Road 383 that, once in it, it would be a very difficult affair indeed to get out of it.
