Now on this day comes the report of viewers appointed by this Court at its Sept Term 1880, to view and estimate as to damage sustained by Lucian Events, by the location and Establishment of the above mentioned road which report of said viewers is to the effect that said Events receives no damage by the location of said Road and therefore award him none. Also comes the Report of the viewers appointed by this Court to view & locate said road for final hearing the same having been heretofore read in open Court on a day of a Term of this Court to wit Sept 9th 1880, and the said viewers appointed to view and locate said road having reported favorably upon the establishment of the same and recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road, & the field notes and plat of survey having been duly filed & certified by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the prayer of the petition & report of the viewers & that said report of viewers and field notes and plat of survey be recorded as by law required.

In the Matter of Pairs
of David L White for 1880

Now on this day it appearing to the Court from the affidavit filed herein of David L White that he has been wrongly assessed by the County assessor for the year 1880 in this that he is not allowed any indebtedness or ~~exceptions~~ and that he had at the time of his said assessment ~~his~~ indebtedness within the state to the amount of \$800⁰⁰ and so notified said County assessor at the time he was assessed. It is therefore ordered by the Court that said David L White be allowed the said amount of \$800⁰⁰ as indebtedness & that the Sheriff as tax Collector give him credit on his total taxable property for the year 1880 the sum of \$800⁰⁰ as indebtedness.
