

Notice is hereby given, to all whom
it may concern, that the undersigned
land holder of Umatilla County and
State of Oregon, and residents in the vic-
inity of the proposed Road herein after
mentioned and described, will at the
September term in 1887 of the County
Court of the State of Oregon for the
County of Umatilla, present to said
Court a Petition asking and pray-
ing said ^{County} Court to lay out locate and
establish a County Road ^{40 feet wide} as follows
to wit: Commencing on the State
line between the State of Oregon and
the Territory of Washington at a
point 5 chains and 50 links west
of where the section line running
north and south between sections
14 and 15 in Township 6 north of
range 35 east W.M. crosses the said
state line. Running thence in a
south easterly direction across the
lands of R. Wells, to the line running
between said sections 14 and 15, at
a point 80 rods north of the south
west corner of said section 14.
Thence south on said section line
on the lands of Lewis Miller and
John Lewis 80 Rods. Thence
south on the section line between
sections 22 and 23 in said town-
ship about three fourths of a mile

1 over the lands of O. N. Bellan and
2 lands belonging to the estate of
3 Alexander Ferguson deceased, and
4 M. F. Smith James Bays and
5 Joseph Perry, thence southerly and
6 on the most practical route
7 over the lands of Joseph Perry A.
8 Moscard, Dr. Clawe, Henry Miller
9 A. Ford, Mr. Crago, C. B. Briggs
10 Charles Anderson, Frank Sulli-

 14 corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 35 in
 15 Township 6 North Range 35 East
 16 W.M. running thence in a southe
 17 easterly direction across said S.W. 1/4 of
 18 said Section, to where said Mudcrack
 19 and Milton road intersect what is
 20 known as the lower road running
 21 from Milton Oregon to the State line.
