Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the March term, _____, of said County Court, to-wit: On the third (3) day of March 1902, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, ^{53 1/2} running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of section twenty seven (27) Township four (4) North Range thirty six (36) East of W. M. Thence South Fifty six (56) Rods thence South East Twelve (12) Rods Thence South West Twenty one (21) Rods to a Point Nine & Half (9 1/2) Rods West of the North East Corner of the south East Quarter of the South East Quarter of section twenty seven (27) township four (4) North Range thirty six (36) East of W. M.

And we Respectfully Ask the Honorable County Court to Vacate County Road Laying between the North West Corner of the south west Quarter of the North West Quarter and the North East Corner of the South West Quarter of section twenty seven (27) Township four (4) North Range thirty six (36) East of W. M.

And between the North East Corner of the South West Quarter of section twenty seven (27) Township Four (4) North of Range thirty six (36) East of W. M. and the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of section Twenty seven (27) Township Four (4) North Range Thirty six (36) East of W. M.

Said road to be Forty (40) feet wide. (Said Roads are numbered (329) and (400))
