FINAL ORDER OF VACATION

Be it remembered that at a regular session of the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, held in the courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A. M., present:

D. R. Cook, County Judge, and J. E. Olinger and Roscoe H. Kelley, County Commissioners, the following proceedings were had:

Whereas, by resolution and order unanimously adopted on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1956, it was declared that proceedings to vacate those portions of County Road #128A hereinafter described, would be undertaken, and said proceedings were instituted, and the County Engineer was notified of said proceedings and was ordered and directed to examine said portions of County Road #128A and to make a report in writing on the same as provided by law; and

Whereas, said County Engineer did examine said portion of County Road #128A, and on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1956, made his report in writing thereon as required by law, and filed said report with the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon, and

Whereas, said notice of hearing was duly given by posting as required by law on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1956, which was more than thirty days before the day set for said hearing; and proof that such notice has been given was made by affidavit of the County Engineer, now on file herein; and

Whereas, pursuant to said order and notice this matter came on duly to be heard by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon in the Courtroom of said Court in the Temporary Umatilla County Courthouse at Pendleton, Oregon on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of February 1956, at 10:00 o'clock, A. M., at which time and place the said report of the County Engineer was duly heard and considered, and the said resolution instituting said proceeding was duly considered and no objection was made by any person to the vacation of said portion of County Road #128A and,

Whereas, it appears to this Court that said portions of County Road #128A are not now in use by the public, and that they will not be a useful part of the general road system of Umatilla County, Oregon, and it further appears that the public will be benefited by the vacation thereof; and the Court being fully advised in the premises;

It Is Hereby Ordered that the following described portions of County Road #128A of Umatilla County, Oregon, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 18, Township 4 North, Range 36 East, Willamette Meridian; thence running South a distance of 1320 feet; thence East, a distance of 1122 feet, thence South 4 degrees East a distance of 3795 feet; thence South 45 degrees East a distance of 330 feet; thence East a distance of 759 feet; thence South 20 degrees East a distance of 825 feet; thence South 10 degrees East a distance of 1551 feet; thence South 25 degrees East a distance of 1452 feet; thence South 18 degrees East a distance of 3267 feet; thence East a distance of 2640 feet; thence South a distance of 1320 feet; thence East a distance of 2640 feet; thence South 40 degrees East a distance of 1095 feet more or less to a point intersecting the section line common to Sections 28 and 29, Township 4 North, Range 36 East Willamette Meridian, and

It Is Further Ordered that this Order be entered in the Journal of this Court.
