The said Viewers having reported favorably and Recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of Survey, being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor, appointed to survey the same, it is therefore Ordered, that the report of Viewers be, and the same is accepted, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road.

It is therefore Ordered that said road be established as a County road in accordance with the report of said Viewers and that the said field notes and plat of Survey, thereof be recorded as required by law, and the Supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use, as a County Road,

In the matter of County road \* 522 commencing at North west corner of the northeast quarter of section thirty four in Township Five north of range thirty four East of the Willamette Meridian, and running in a southeasterly direction along the present traveled road, until it intersects Oregon Railway and Navigation Company's right of way, thence westerly crossing said right of way at right angles, thence to the western line thereof, thence in a southeasterly direction following the road as now travelled, to its intersection with the Township line between Township Four and Five, in Range thirty-four East of the Willamette Meridian

Now on this day come the reports of the Viewers J. J. Price, L. J. Mc Bride and J. A. Baddley, Surveyor appointed at the January 1901 Term of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a County road, for final hearing, the same having been read at a previous day of this term of Court to wit the March 1901 Term, and the said Viewers having reported favorably, and recommended, the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of Survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor, appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road, It is therefore Ordered, that the report of Viewers be, and the same is <sup>hereby</sup> accepted,

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It is therefore ordered, that said road be established as a county road, in accordance with the report of said viewers and that the said field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as required by law, and the supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a county road.

In the matter of County Road # 523 commencing at the terminus of road # 422, on the north line of the NW<sup>1</sup> of the NW<sup>4</sup> of Sec 21, Tp. 2 N Range 32 E. W. 711. Thence in a southerly direction crossing the line between Secs 20 and 21, and Termination at the initial point of road # 437, in the SE<sup>4</sup> of the SE<sup>4</sup> of Section 20, Tp. 2 North, R 32 E W. 711. said proposed road, to be about 1 1/2 miles in length.

Now on this day comes the report of the viewers of Barnhart B F Rinn and T D Newford, heretofore appointed at the January, 1901 Term of this Court, to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a county road, for final hearing, the same having been read, upon a previous day of this term of this Court, to-wit the January 1901 Term and the said viewers having reported favourably, and recommended the establishing the same as a county road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file, and certified to, by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrances on file against said road, it is therefore ordered that the report of the viewers be accepted.

It is, therefore ordered, that said road be established as a county road, in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the said field notes, and plat of survey, thereof be recorded, as required by law, and the supervisor through whose district said road runs, be directed, to open the same for public use, as a county road.

In the matter of proposed County road # 525, described as commencing at the S.E. corner of Section 11, in Tp 5 N R 32 E W 711 running thence due South and on the Section line, to the S.E. corner of the NE<sup>4</sup> of Section 14.
