That, we, Ambros Winn, and Malinda Winn, his wife, the undersigned, being the owners of all the deeded lands over which it is desired to establish a County Road in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, described as follows: Beginning at a point at the Base of the hill on the West side of Dry Creek where the present County Road starts up the hill and about one hundred sixty (160) rods in a North Easterly direction from the South West corner of section 23 Township 5 North, of range 35 T. W. M. Running thence in a Southwesterly direction up the Gulch or Canyon and on the West and North of the present Road a distance of two Hundred (200) rods to again intersect the County Road as now located.

Which said Road is to be sixty feet wide, in consideration of the of the acceptance by the County Court of Umatilla County, Oregon, of such dedicated road as a County Road hereby dedicated forever to the use of the public all our right, title, and interest in and to all of the lands described in said above described road. Now on this day the Summary of the Assessment roll of Umatilla County, Oregon as returned by the assessor of Umatilla County, Oregon showing Real and Personal property assessed to the amount of \$5,663,918.54 and polls assessed to the amount of \$1,077.⁰⁰ the above being the net assessment of Umatilla County, upon which the County Court of Umatilla County is authorized by law, to make the assessment of 1902.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that a tax of Twenty Eight (28) Mills be levied upon the net assessment of real, and personal property as returned by the assessor of Umatilla County for the Year 1902, to-wit on the sum of \$5,663,918.54 to be, as follows.
For State and County purposes Twenty-two and Nine tenths (22-9/10) Mills on each dollar worth of taxable property payable in coin. For school purposes Five (5) Mills on each dollar worth of taxable property payable in coin.
For Road fund One tenth (1/10) Mill on each dollar worth of taxable property payable in coin.

It is further ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court make a transcript of said assessment, and extend the taxes in accordance with the levy as above made by this Court, and that the said Clerk shall attach a warrant to said transcript of assessment and deliver the same to the Sheriff of Umatilla County, Oregon, which said warrant shall authorize the collection of said taxes for the Year 1902, by said Sheriff and the said Sheriff be charged with the amount of said levy on said amount, of \$5,663,918.54 at the rate of Twenty Eight mills on the dollar and \$1,077.⁰⁰ polls returned in said assessment for the Year 1902 by the assessor.
