paid to them; the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the South Half of the Northwest Quarter and the North Half of the Southwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter

of Section 23 Township 4 North, Range 35 East W. M. Beginning at Station 179 A 05 of the Weston Mountain Highway Survey

which Station is approximately 548 feet West and feet of the S.E. Corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 23, Twp. 4 N. R. 35 E. W.M. which is common to Sections Township Range East W. M.

Thence running in a Northwestly direction approximately 4350 feet to Station 222 A 55 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 715 feet North and feet of the Quarter corner which is common to Sections 22, and 23 Township 4 North, Range 35 East W. M. Contains 6.0 acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
