Now on this day comes the Report of the viewers heretofore appointed at the November term, 1896, of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been read upon a previous day of this term of Court, to-wit: the January term, 1896, and the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County road, and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file against said road, said road being described as follows: Commencing at the South East Corner of the North-East quarter of Section four, Township three North, Range 36 East Willamette Meridian; thence running North on Section line as near as practical for one-half mile to the North east corner of Section four; thence running East for a distance of one mile on the most practical route and terminating at the North east corner of Section 3, all in the same Township and Range. Said Road to be 40 feet wide.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the Report of said Viewers be accepted and that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with said Report and the report of said viewers, field notes and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and that
