Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing upon the resolution of the above entitled court for the vacating of the above roadway, and it appearing to the Court that a resolution has been filed and entered herein for the vacation of the same, and that the Deputy Roadmaster should examine said road, and make and file his report in writing on the same, and the Court being now fully advised in the matter, it is

ORDERED that the Deputy Roadmaster of Umatilla County, Oregon, examine the following roadway, to-wit:

Beginning at the center of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 35, E.W.M.; thence in a southe asterly direction to the north east corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 34, and known as County Road No. 100; also beginning at the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 34, Township 4 North, Range 35; thence in a south-easterly direction to a point where Road No. 74 crosses the section line between sections 1 and 12, Township 3 North, Range 35, E.W.M., and make a report in writing on the same, and to include in said report his opinion as to whether the road should be vacated, whether the dame is in use or has been in use, whether it will be advisable to preserve the same for general road system in the future, whether the public will be benefitted by the vacation, and all other facts, matters and things which will be of importance to the above entitled court in determining whether or not said road should be vacated, and to file said report upon completion with the County Clerk of this County.
