REPORT OF DEPUTY  
COUNTY ROADMASTER

I, David R. Temple, do depose and say that I am the  
duly appointed and authorized and acting Deputy Roadmaster of  
Umatilla County, Oregon.

I have viewed the road described in the attached copy  
of the resolution, i.e., beginning at a point which point is the  
center of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 35, E. W. M.,  
thence in a southeasterly direction for a distance of approx-  
imately two and one half miles to a point where County Road No.  
74 crosses the section line between sections 1 and twelve in  
Township 3 North, Range 35, E.W.M., and it is my opinion that  
the said road should be vacated for the following reasons: it  
has not been used for some time, is very steep and dangerous to  
travel, is not necessary to the locality, and does not justify  
the burden of maintenance and that the public will be benefited  
by its vacation.
