In the matter of Location  
of County Road commencing  
at Corner of B Davis  
Said Claim and thence  
To Wild Horse Creek

Now on this day Comes this  
road up for final hearing And it appearing to the  
Court that there is now no remonstrance to said  
road and the petition for damages of Chas R Allen  
having been withdrawn which was presented  
to the Court April 5<sup>th</sup> 1875 and he having with-  
drawn his objections It is now therefore ordered  
that said road be granted as a public highway  
in accordance with the Plat and Survey of said  
road & the prayer of the petitioners & the supervisor  
in said District is hereby ordered to open said road &  
keep the same in good repair

in the matter of the location  
of County Road from State line  
To Intersect County Road leading  
from Milton To Mud Creek

Now on this day Comes a  
petition praying for the location of a County Road Commencing  
on the State line between Sec 14 & 15 in T. 6. N  
R. 35, E. & running due south  $\frac{3}{4}$  of mile thence on  
the nearest and most practicable route until it intersect  
the County Road leading from Mud Creek to Milton  
And it appearing to the satisfaction of this Court that  
the law has been complied with in the premises

It is now therefore ordered by this Court that  
Mr Nichols Mr McCoy & Mr Frazier be and they  
are hereby appointed Reversers of said proposed road  
to meet July 21<sup>st</sup> 1875 and proceed in company with  
the Co Surveyor to view out survey and mark off said  
road as the law directs and make due return of  
their proceedings to this Court at the next  
regular term in September
