

In County Court January Term 1882
 11th Judicial Day Tuesday 24th

In the Matter of a County Road from the
 N 7 1/4 Sec 18. T5 N R 33 E. down the South
 fork of Grapes Canyon to its Mouth

Now on this day comes the report of the
 viewers appointed to view and locate the above mentioned Road for
 its first reading, as well as the Claim of A B Remick for damages sus-
 tained by him to his land claim by the location of said above
 mentioned Road in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars & Co.
 It is therefore ordered by the Court that Thomas Kendall J. H. Bryant
 and J. H. Miller be and they are hereby appointed as viewers to
 view and estimate as to the damage if any sustained to the
 said A B Remick's land claim by the location of said Road,
 and that they report their damag^{estimation} to this Court at the April
 Term thereof next to wit April 4th 1882. and that they meet
 at the House of A B Remick on the 21st day of February A D 1882 and
 duly qualify before entering upon their duties in this behalf

In the Matter of County Road from the
 N W Cor of sec 6. to S W Cor of N 7 1/4 of
 Sec 33 T4 N R 34 E

Now on this day come the report
 of the viewers appointed by the Court to view out & locate the above
 mentioned Road as a County Road for its final reading the same
 having been read on a previous day of a term of this Court to wit
 Sept 8th 1881 and the said viewers having reported favorably and
 recommending the establishment of said Road as a County Road
 and also comes the report of the viewers appointed at the Septem-
 ber term of this Court to view and estimate damage sustained
 by the location of said Road to Mrs Woodward, which
 said last mentioned report awards the sum of one
 thousand dollars to the said Mrs Woodward by
 said road being located across his land.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said Road be
 established as a County road in accordance with the
 prayer of the Petitioners & report of said viewers upon the
 condition that the Petitioners herein pay to the said Mrs
 Woodward the said sum of one thousand dollars as
 awarded by the said viewers appointed to assess the
 damage thereon and upon the payment of said sum of one
 thousand dollars as aforesaid, the Clerk of this Court shall record the
 said Report field notes & plat of survey as by law required the same to be
 filed with this Court.
