To All Persons Whom it May Concern:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon. for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the July term of said County Court, to-wit: on the 6th day of July 1891. praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit:

Commencing Where the wagon road bridge crosses Wild Horse creek just above the range line between 34 and 35 thence along south side of the W.D.R.R track to the Range line between 34 and 35 thence south on Range line to N.E. corner of Sect 25 Township 4 N.R. 35 E thence west on sect line to crossing of the W.D.R.R thence along side said track near the present traveled road to the center of Sect 9 Township 3 N.R. 34 East thence south to the Deminished Indian Reservation

line thence west on sect line to N.E. corner of Sect 17 Township 3 N.R. 31 E thence south N.E. corner of Sect 20 Township 3 N.R. 34 E thence west on sect line to N.E. corner of Sect 19 Township 3 N.R. 34 E thence south to Reservation line thence west on said line to the N.E. corner Sect 25 Township 3 N.R. 33 E thence thence south on Reservation line to the N.E. corner of Sect 30 Township 3 N.R. 33 E thence west on sect line 3 miles to N.E. corner Sect 20 Township 3 N.R. 33 E thence

an east line 3 miles to N.E. corner  
Sect 33. Township 3 N.R. 33 E thence  
south 1/2 mile thence west one mile  
through center of Sect 33 to N.E. corner  
of T. E. 14 Sect 32 Township 3 N.R. 33 E  
thence westerly direction on the  
Practable Route to the wagon Road  
bridge across the Umatilla River  
about 3/4 mile above Pendleton thence  
across said bridge to where the  
wagon Road intersects Court Street  
in the city of Pendleton  
Umatilla County Oregon.
