

COUNTY-BUREAU AGREEMENT  
UMATILLA INDIAN RESERVATION  
UMATILLA COUNTY, OREGON

THIS AGREEMENT made this 9th day of January, 1959  
by and between the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, hereinafter  
referred to as the COUNTY and the Umatilla Indian Reservation, under  
the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs,  
Portland Area, hereinafter referred to as the BUREAU.

This agreement is made in the light of the following  
facts and circumstances:

1. The BUREAU agrees to recondition a section of Umatilla  
Reservation Route 30, known as the Hall-Toyslap Road from  
the Northwest corner of Section 36, T3N, R33E, W.M., thence  
east approximately four miles to Northeast corner of  
Section 33, T3N, R34E, W.M. The reconditioning will be  
done to the following standard:

Reshape roadbed to 27 foot subgrade width.  
Apply 6" Compacted Base Course.  
Apply 3" Compacted Surface Course.  
Gravel surface width to be 24 feet.

2. The BUREAU agrees to obtain right of way easements on  
Indian lands and prepare the right of way maps necessary  
to complete the transfer of the easement applied for under  
paragraph 3 below.
3. The COUNTY hereby makes application for the right of way  
easement on the section of Route 30 described above.
