

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY,

In the Matter of Locating, Establishing, :  
Altering, Widening, Straightening and :  
Changing a County Road : Road No. 894.  
From the Helix-Vansycle Market Road at :  
Stanton Station northeasterly to the :  
summit of the hill. :

Now on this day this matter coming on now to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road and said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court to-wit: Having been publicly read the first time on November 7th, 1929 and publicly read the second time on November 8th, 1929, and is now up for final hearing and it duly appearing that no objections or exceptions are on file against said road or report and said board of viewers finds that said road as located, surveyed and laid out to be a feasible and necessary one and a benefit to the public, therefore, it respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a County Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The Board also finds that the lands through which the proposed road is laid out will not be made less valuable by reason of its establishment.

IT IS THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be adopted in full and that said road be established and declared a public Highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.
