IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that such portion of said County Road No. 164, is useless and dangerous to maintain and is of no value to individuals or to the general public and is useless as part of the road system of Umatilla County, and that the public will be benefitted by its vacation and the same is hereby VACATED.
