

# Notice.

In the name of the State of Oregon; Notice is hereby given, to all whom it may concern, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders in the vicinity of the hereinafter proposed county road and are petitioners for the laying out of the same; that application will be made by petition of the said undersigned and others, to the Hon. County Court of Umatilla county, in the State of Oregon, at the next regular term thereof to wit: at one o'clock P. M. on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1881, asking that a county road be duly located <sup>and opened</sup> on the following described line viz: Commencing at a point on the line between sections 12 & 13 in T<sup>p</sup> 4 N Range 33 <sup>in said State & County,</sup> East, where a traveled road crosses said line — said point being about 30 rods East of the S. W. corner of said section 12; from thence running west to the S. W. corner of said section 12; from thence running South to the S. E. corner of section 14 in said T<sup>p</sup> and Range; from thence running west 80 rods; from thence running South-westerly to a point which is 60 rods East of the N. E. <sup>corner</sup> of the S. W. 1/4 of section 23 in said T<sup>p</sup> & Range; from thence running West 60 rods; from thence running South on a straight line to where said line crosses Wild-horse creek, all in Umatilla County in the State of Oregon.
