

In the Matter of County Road No. 772
Petitioned for by R.O. Earnheart et al. Road No. 772.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 772 petitioned for as follows: Commencing 67 rods South of the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 30 Tp. 4 N.R. 32 E.W.M. and running 40 rods in a Southeasterly direction terminating where it joins the present County Road, also vacating the present County Road commencing and terminating at the same points but running about 4 rods farther South, said road to be 60 feet wide, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court. And the Board of County Road Viewers having recommended that said road be established and the plat and field notes being on file and there being no objections or remonstrances on file against said road, it is hereby ORDERED by the Court that said report of the County road viewers be approved and that the road supervisor through whose ~~tax~~ district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered to open said road for public use, and he is further ordered to vacate said old road.
