

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point in Section 9 (nine) in Township 5 (five) North of Range 33 East of the Willamette Meridian, of the County road no. 313-150 rods Northwestwardly from the point of intersection of said County road with the South line of said Section 9 (nine) - thence, running Northwestwardly and North of said County road, by the most practicable route, 128 rods to a point on the said County road or the extension thereof - the said proposed route for a County road, being distant from said original county road at the point of its greatest distance 13 rods and running by the most practicable route Northwestwardly from said point of commencing to the said terminal point on said County road ^{or the extension thereof} all being situated in said Section 9 in Township 5 North of Range 33 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon, and said proposed route for a County road being situated and located upon the lands owned by Joseph Ringel and Norman G. Butler, and lands adjacent - said road to be 60 (sixty) feet wide, and further petition your honorable body to vacate that portion of said County road, as now established, ~~between~~ lying between the place of beginning and the place of ending of said proposed county road,
 Said road to be _____ feet wide.
