To the Honorable Court of Umatilla County Oregon
March 21, 1901.

We the undersigned having been appointed by your honorable body to view and locate Road Number 524. Situated and being in section 9. of Tp 5 North of Range 33 E W. M. met to E. Macomber County Surveyor at the beginning of the road and calling to our aid A. A. Boynton. and W. F. Stockman as Chaimmen and to E. Macomber Marker. proceeded to view and survey said Road Number 524 and find the proposed change to be in every way desirable and recommend that the road as surveyed and located be accepted and that portion of the Old Road # 313 lying parallel to and which it is proposed to replace. by the new survey be vacated

Field notes of Survey of Road # 524.

In accordance with an order issued by the County Court at their March term 1901. I met R. E. Dunnington, A. E. Brotherton and Benj Stanton. Appointed as Viewers of Road # 524. at the beginning of said Road and calling to our aid A. A. Boynton. and W. F. Stockman to act as Chaimmen I administered the usual Oath. and then proceeded to survey and locate said Road # 524.

beginning at a point on Road # 313 - 150 rods (as measured by fall lines) from the intersection of said Road with the south line of sec 9. Tp 5 N R 33 E. W. M. and northerly from from said intersection I planted post marked R. 524. 30' to the left thence N. 4° 45' W 516 then angle Left 32° 20'
N 37° 05' W 584 = 1100 then angle right 4° 05'
N 33° 00' W 425 = 1525 then angle left 19° 00'
N 52° 00' W 675 = 2200 from which point 30' to the left I set post marked RT 524 to mark end of survey
