In the matter of Locating, establishing, altering, changing and widening a county road, same being designated as Vansycle-Juniper Market Road.

RESOLUTION

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS there now exists in Umatilla County, State of Oregon what is known as Vansycle-Juniper Market Road, same being a County Road and highway in the aforesaid county and state, and

WHEREAS in order that the said Highway and road may be located, established altered, widened straightened and changed, it is necessary to appropriate certain lands belonging to one Edgar L. Smith and Mercy E. Smith, his wife, and

WHEREAS this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said court being now in regular session, sitting for the transaction of County business with a majority of the members of said court present,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of the County of Umatilla State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of June, 1924 in the County court room at the county court house in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of county business, that it is, and is hereby declared to be the intentions of the said court, court to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a highway or road on and over a route as follows:

All that part of the property of Edgar L. Smith and Mercy E. Smith his wife, in the South half of Section 1, township 5 North, Range 32 East, W.M. included within a strip of land 30 feet wide, being thirty feet on the north side of the center line of the Vansycle-Juniper Market road as surveyed and staked over and across said property said center line being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point known and designated as station 99 1/2 on the said center line survey, said point being 30 feet south and 550 feet west of the section corner common to section 1 and 12, township 5 North, Range 32 E.W.M. and sections 6 and 7 Township 5, N.R. 33 E.W.M. thence North 68° 59' West 0.0 feet; thence on a 319.6 foot radius curve to the left, 137.0 feet; thence south 86° 21' west; 863.1 feet; thence south 86° 06' West, 3357.6 feet; thence on a 573.7 foot radius curve to the left, 126.2 feet to a point known and designated as Station 43 1/2 83.8 on the said center line survey, said point being 30 feet south and 282 feet east of the section corner common to sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 township 5 North, Range 32 EW.M.

Also all that part of the property of Edgar L. Smith and Mercy E. Smith his wife, in the North half of Section 11, Tp. 5 N.R. 32 E.W.M. included within a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet wide on each side of the center line of the Vansycle-Juniper Market Road as surveyed and staked over and across said property, said center line being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point known and designated as Station 146 1/2 76.0 on the said center line survey, said point being 80 feet south of the section corner common to Section 1, 2, 11 and 12, township 5 North Range 32 E.W.M. thence south 73° 29' West, 1401.7 feet, thence on a 573.7 foot radius curve to the right, 424.0 feet; thence North 64° 07' West, 529.5 feet, thence on a 359.3 foot radius curve to the left, 279.6 feet, thence south 71° 09' west, 934.4 feet, thence on a 1432.7 foot radius curve to the right 771.7 feet; thence North 77° 59' West 711.1 feet; thence on a 2864.9 foot radius curve to the left, 446.7 feet to a point known and designated as station 203 1/2 17.5 on the said center line survey, said point being 63 feet south of the section corner common to sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, township 5 N.R. 32 E.W.M. said parcels of land contains 10.88 acres, more or less, of which 2.15 acres more or less are included in the old county road. the width of said right of way or road to be a strip of land thirty feet wide on each side of the above described line, making a total roadway of sixty feet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public necessity for said highway or road is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: That in order to straighten and eliminate the curves and to effect a suitable grade and for the purpose of accommodating motor traffic, it is essential that the road be built over and across the land hereinabove described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, be and he is hereby requested to bring such condemnation proceedings as may be necessary to condemn the said property as by law provided, for the purposes hereinabove referred to and that a true copy of this resolution be duly entered in the Commissioners Journal.
