In the Matter of Locating, Establishing, Altering, Widening, Straightening and Changing a County Road.....
running from a point in the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, Township 5 North, Range 33 East, W.M. Northerly down Vansycle Canyon to a point in the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 33 East, W.M. to be known and designated as County Road No. 879. In Umatilla County, Oregon. Said proposed road is a section of the Helix-Vansycle Market Road.

RESOLUTION

County Road No. 879.....

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable that a County Road or Highway be located, established, altered, widened, straightened and changed from a point in the center of County Road No. 313 in the Northwest Quarter of Section 27, down Vansycle Canyon to a point near Vansycle Station at an intersection with the Vansycle-Juniper Market Road.

and that said Road or Highway be located, established, altered, widened, straightened and changed by resolution of the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon.

AND WHEREAS, this being a regular term of the Umatilla County Court and the said Court being now in regular session, sitting for the transaction of County Business with all members of said Court present.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Court of Umatilla County, State of Oregon, sitting at the regular monthly term for the month of October 1928, in the County Court Room of the Court House, in Pendleton, Umatilla County, State of Oregon, for the transaction of County business, that it is and is hereby declared to be the intention of the said County Court to locate, establish, alter, widen, straighten and change a road or highway on and over a route as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed County Road No. 879

shall commence, run and terminate as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of County Road No. 313 from which the Section corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28, bears North, 385 feet and West 148 feet, thence running Northerly down Vansycle Canyon, following the survey of the Vansycle-Helix Market Road as the same is now to staked, to a point of ending which is 730 feet North and 1775 feet West of the Center of Section 5, all in Township 5 North, Range 33 East, W.M.

The right of way or roadway to be a strip of land Sixty feet wide, being Thirty feet wide on each side of the center line of the proposed road, of the above described line.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public necessity for the said road or highway is hereby declared to exist for the following reasons, to-wit: It is a designated Market Road and is necessary to care for the traffic and travel of this territory, the present roads being inadequate and often impassable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above entitled matter be heard at the regular November term for the year 1928, of said County Court at the County Court House at Pendleton, in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that true copies of this Resolution, properly certified to as such by the County Clerk be posted by the County Roadmaster as follows, to-wit: That a copy be posted upon the bulletin board in the west corridor of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, said Court House being the place where the County Court is held; That three copies be posted in three public places in the vicinity of the said proposed road; And that this Resolution be duly entered in the Commissioners Journal.
