Report of Viewers, Field notes and plat of survey of County Road No 345 in Multnomah County Or. Commencing at Road Stake on County Road in North Juniper Cañon near School House at the SW corner of Sec 235 NR 32 E 10m. Thence North on Sec line to the middle of Sec 26 36 NR 32 E 10m. Thence East $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the center of Sec 26. Thence North about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Cañon leading to Vausyke Cañon, thence down said Cañon near Lone Rock Thence angle around the hill on the most practical route to Cañon Station on the O & W. T.R.R. said Road to be 50 feet wide.

To the Hon County Court

The undersigned viewers heretofore appointed to view and lay out Road No 345, submit the following report, Pursuant to order of the Hon Court Geo B. Clark viewer undersigned met with Jno C. Arnold at Mr. Reuick's house Aug 5th 1890. Mr. Kievan being away out of the county, Mr. A. R. Gordon was set for but was also away attending a sick daughter and the said Geo B. Clark being himself sick and unable to attend to duties of Road viewer, it was thought best in view of the immediate and pressing necessity for action in the matter of said road No 345, that the Surveyor call Jno L. Stoekman and Edgar Thomson to chain and mark the said road as by us instructed and to employ such other help as might be found necessary and forthwith proceed to the said survey and that we, the undersigned should go over the said road as surveyed and marked out, and which we have done in company with Jno L. Stoekman sworn chain and marker we find the route quite practicable, the grade down the hill to Vausyke Cañon at Cañon Station is a fine one, the road is very much needed by the community and the

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General Public,

We would recommend that said road No 345 become a Public highway

Witness our respective hands this 8th day of August A.D. 1890.

We believe the above road should be granted as it is a very necessary one in getting wheat to the station

~ Field Notes Road Survey No 345~
in Umatilla County Oregon.

I met Geo B. Clark, viewer at A. B. Reviets house Aug 5th 6.30 am. A.D. 1890 and administer to him the usual road viewers oath, Mr Clark having just returned from W. W. hospital says he is sick and unable to attend the survey in person - word is brought that H. R. Gordon viewer is attending the bed side of a dangerously sick daughter and J. L. Millian viewer is not in the county, viewer Clark says the road is much needed and the petitioners would be greatly disappointed in delaying the survey, that there is no fighting the road, to his knowledge and that the viewers would be guided principally by Jno L. Stockman who prepared the petition and thinks I would better survey the road under direction of Mr Stockman and he in company with at least one of the viewers will go over the survey within five days and make their report to the Court, I therefore call Jno L. Stockman and Edgar Thomson to chain and mark and on post terminus for road No 344 which is set N 36° E 33' distant from cor claimed to be Sec 2 T 5 R 32 E. I set R 345 on north face and from said cor Sec 2 I run on line bet Secs 2 & 3

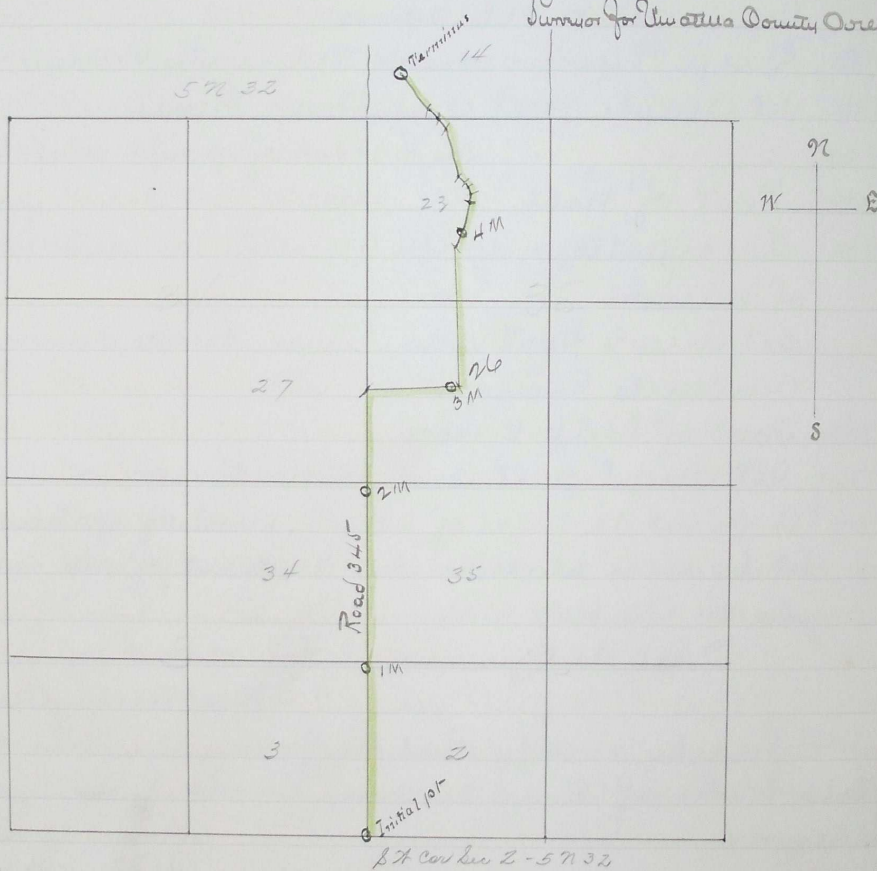
