

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts, where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located, and established a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to wit: Commencing at a point in the center of the County Road leading from Holdman to Malix, being County Road No. 88 which point is northeasterly, measured along the center line of said road, a distance of 3273 feet from the center point of intersection of said road with the Pendleton--Cold Springs Highway, said Highway being known as U. S. No. 395; running thence in a northeasterly direction along the most practical route to the point of termination which point is 1488 feet west and 151.4 feet north of the center of section 24, Township 5 North, Range 31, E. W. N.

said road to be forty Feet wide

We respectfully show that there is a public necessity for said road road, in that, the lands through and to which said road will lead are not at present reached by any convenient county road.

And your petitioners will ever pray, etc.
