

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

In the matter of opening county road  
No. 638 petitioned for by Newton  
Miller, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the January 1908 term of this Court to view, survey, stake, lay out and report upon said road No. 638 as follows: Commencing at the SE corner SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 11, Tp. 5 N. R. 31 EWM. thence in a Northeasterly direction to the NE corner said Section 11, thence in a Northeasterly direction through section 1, Tp. 5 N. R. 31 EWM. to the NW corner of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, said Section 1 and to be 40 ft wide, as a county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit: Having been publicly read the 1st time on Feb. 6, 1908 and publicly read the 2nd time on Feb. 8, 1908. And the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of said road as a county road and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same, and it appearing to the Court that said road would be of sufficient public utility, it is hereby ORDERED that said report of the board of county road viewers be accepted and the plats and field notes be recorded in the Records of Plats and Field Notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs, be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use as soon as the damages to be sustained by William Mills through Sec. 1, Tp. 5 N. R. 31 EWM. amounting to \$275.00 be paid or adjusted by the petitioners.
