ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the May term, 1901, of said County Court, to-wit: On the 8th day of May, 1901, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the quarter-section corner on the section line between Sections 3 and 4, in Township 5, North of Range 32, E.W.M., running thence North two miles and a half to the South-west corner of Section 22, in Township 6, North of Range 32, E.W.M.; thence at right angles East along the section line upon the present travelled road one-half mile, to the quarter-section corner on the South line of said Section 22; thence at right angles North one-half mile to the center of said Section 22; thence North-easterly down the canon, across the North-east quarter of said Section 22, on the most practicable route down said canon, to the ware-house at Canon Station on the line of the Washington and Columbia River Railroad, where said station is located in the South-west quarter of Section 14, Township 6, North of Range 32, E.W.M.
